CHILD DEVELOPMENT HOSTS ANNUAL JAMBOREE



This summer, the CalFresh Healthy Living (CFHL) program teamed up with TCCI Child Development to implement Grow It, Try, It, Like It! (GITILI)—a gardenthemed nutrition curriculum for preschoolers designed to introduce and encourage consumption of different fruits and vegetables. Each set of GITILI lessons contains hands-on activities, planting activities, crafts projects, and nutrition education activities that introduce MyPlate.

HOMEWORK HELP LAB & TUTORING AT FSC



The FamilySource Center offers a Homework Help Lab and Tutoring Services for youth in middle and high school. The subcontractor, Dynasty United Youth Association (DUYA) assigned tutors to help increase student academic achievement. The Homework Help Lab is available from 3pm-6pm on Tuesday and Thursday for youth to get assistance completing homework assignments, school projects, and guidance for academic exams. The youth enrolled in Tutoring Service are assessed to identify academic benchmarks and provided private tutoring in basic skills of Math and English.
