BIH CELEBRATES BLACK MOMS

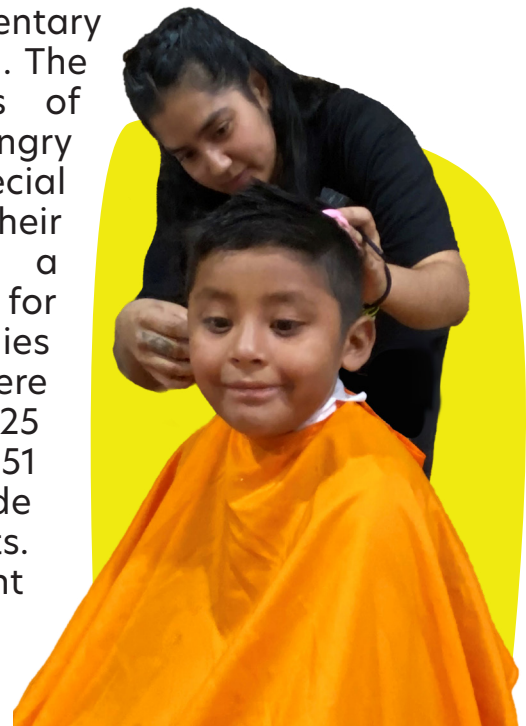

We were able to distribute 25 boxes of food and 51 backpacks and provide 18 children with haircuts. In total, the event reached 100 people.

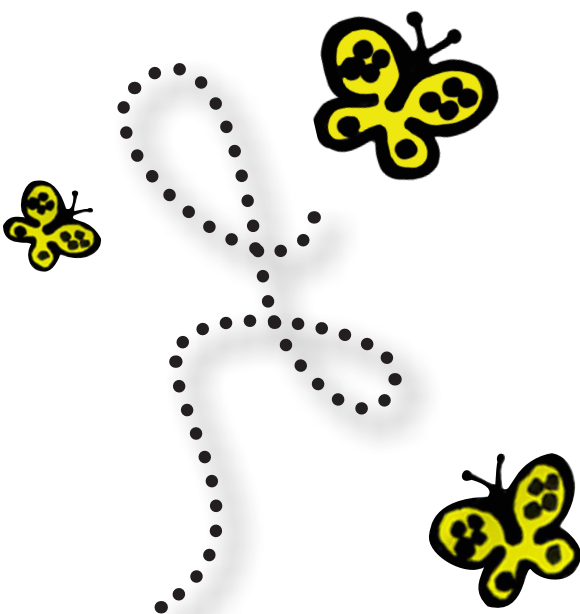

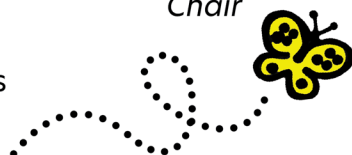
