us for our unforgettable field trip to Catalina Island, where learning and adventure came together in the best


way possible!

CalFresh Healthy Living has completed their fifth term. Over the last weeks, the team has been compiling supply boxes for each of the child care sites. These supply boxes contain tools for the teachers and kids to utilize for physical activity and nutrition education. With the closeout of the term, we want to make sure sites have a variety to tools so that the kids can engage in different activities.

As a program we will continue to support sites with nutrition education, physical activity and produce distributions.



We will continue to provide resources on healthy eating and continue to implement the Organizational Wellness Policy.

#### **Produce Distributions:**

At the end of the term, we were able to complete the following:

- 50 produce distributions.
- Compile 2,250 produce bags
- Serve 6,761 households

# IN THE COMMUNITY WITH BIH

In October, Black Infant Health (BIH) continued to provide comprehensive support services to participants through weekly group sessions. Prenatal and postpartum group discussions covered topics such as "Feeding and Strengthening Our Bodies," "Reflecting on Feeding Baby," "Accessing Social and Community Support," and "Strengthening Our Postpartum Bodies." These sessions provided participants with opportunities to learn, share experiences, and engage in meaningful discussions that fostered mutual support among mothers.

In addition, the BIH team and participants engaged in a variety of activities throughout the month. On October 16th, TCCI BIH partnered with the Department of Public Health to host a Breast Cancer Awareness Community Health Fair at the MLK Jr. Center for Public Health in South Los Angeles. During this event, BIH participants received valuable information on health and nutrition and had the opportunity to participate in a fresh produce distribution, where they received fruits and vegetables to support healthy eating habits.

On October 18th, BIH participated in the annual Taste of Soul Community Festival to connect with the community and promote both the TCCI and BIH programs. During the event, BIH staff engaged with more than 400 individuals through flyer distribution, booth outreach, and social media interactions. The festival provided an exciting opportunity for community engagement, with several current and former BIH participants and their families in attendance.
